Dorothy Starr , 88, life-long Wayne Co. resident peacefully passed away July 4, 2011 at her home. 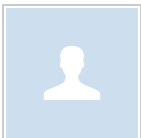

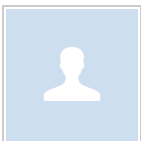
