January 3, 1953 - May 20, 2009

Wooster-Dwight E. Osborne(56), went to be with the Lord Jesus Christ on May 20, 2009 at The Cleveland Clinic after fighting an aggressive brief battle of Lymphoma.

Dwight was born January 3, 1953 in Mansfield, Ohio, the son of John and Frances (McFadden) Osborne.

Dwight and his family attends the Wooster Grace Brethren Church.

Dwight had been employed at several area banks including Peoples Federal and First Merit, and was on permanent disability from First National Bank of Orrville due to suffering with Parkinson's Disease and Sarcoidosis.

In 2002, Dwight and his wife started Osborne Cleaning Service. Due to health issues, Dwight eventually had to hand over the active duties to Sharon.

Dwight enjoyed playing an active roll in his children's lives. In the past, he had served as a Triway Little League Coach.

Surviving are his wife, Sharon(Sperr)Osborne whom he married on August 23, 1975 in Mansfield, Ohio, a daughter Ericka (Eric) Vizzo and a son, Scott (Lyn) Osborne all of Wooster; grandchildren: Mekhi Osborne and Addison Vizzo of Wooster whom he loved dearly. A brother, Dwayne (Valerie)Osborne of Mansfield, Ohio and sisters, DeLaine Osborne of Mansfield, Ohio and Deneice (Larry) Cooper of Westerville, Ohio, nieces Amanda and Jenna Cooper of Westerville, Ohio.

He was preceded in death by his parents, John and Frances Osborne.
