Helen M. Simpson, age 95, of Wooster, passed away, Friday, November 13, 2015 at West View Healthy Living in Wooster following a period of declining health.

She was born on October 15, 1920 in Rittman, Oh. She was the daughter of Harvey and Zulma (Minouflet) Studer and was the oldest of eleven children. She previously had lived in Longvale, CA. for 9 years where she was Owner/Operator of two nursing care facilities.
