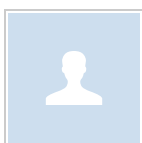

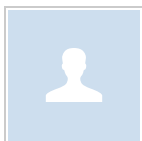

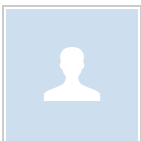
You know, I didn't know Kathy very well, but we did share the bond of working together, albeit as secretaries in different schools in Wooster City Schools.
