Born in Petersburg, Ontario, to John and Matilda (Swartzentruber) Roth on September 1, 1927, Martha lived a rich full life.

She attended Ontario Mennonite Bible School, and studied two years at Eastern Mennonite College, Harrisonburg, VA.

In her eighth summer of Voluntary Service she managed Camp Ebenezer, where she met Jack Miller. He became her husband on June 12, 1954. The two enjoyed ten summers at Camp Luz, with Jack as Manager and Martha as Cook.

Martha was very active in church work, especially enjoying the Mennonite Women's group. She was church historian almost 20 years, and taught Sunday School and Bible School.

Her hobbies were oil painting, embroidering pictures, traveling with her husband, flower arranging and all manner of crafts.

She was a homemaker who worked at Wooster High cafeteria 18 years and St. Mary's and Grant Street Schools. She loved quantity cooking at church, Camp Luz, and Meals Together. She loved to entertain.
