Regina H. Rice, 80, passed away Thursday, July 21, 2011 following a lengthy battle with cancer.

She was born October 23, 1930 in Fredericksburg to the Late Cyril and Helen Chenevey. She was a 1948 graduate of Fredericksburg High School and was class valedictorian. She married Earl R. Rice on April 15, 1950 at St.
