Roland D. Miller, age 65, of Wooster, went home to be with the Lord, Saturday September 13th, 2008 at his residence surrounded by his family and friends following a short illness.

He served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Conflict from 1964-1966 and married Carol J. (Stocker) on December 18, 1966 in Wooster. She survives.

He previously worked for the Rubbermaid Co. in Wooster retiring after 30 years; his main hobby was working with numerous Jeweler's in the area by helping to design jewelry pieces; worked most recently with the Miller Lumber Co. in Millersburg; was a member and held numerous positions with the Church of Light Foursquare Gospel Church in Wooster.

In addition to his mother of Millersburg and beloved wife, he is survived by his children, Tina (Michael) Nason of Shreve, Tricia Miller and Timothy Miller both of Wooster; 2 granddaughters; siblings, Virginia "Ginny" Wiebe of Florida, Faye (Robert) Wriston of Mansfield, ohio, Mark (Deborah) Miller of Orrville and Fraun (Roger) Holcomb of Virginia.
