Her wish was to live in the hearts of those she loved until we meet again.

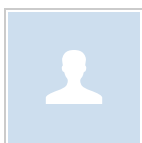

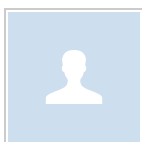
