Silas D. "Si" Nutter, age 94, of Wooster, went home to be with the Lord, Monday evening, January 11th, 2010 at Wooster Community Hospital following a sudden illness.

Services will be Friday, 12:00 p.m. at Custer-Glenn Funeral Home, 2284 Benden Dr., Wooster with Pastor Jeremy Stasiowski officiating followed by interment at Ohio Western Reserve National Cemetery in Rittman.

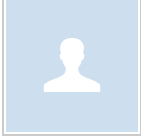

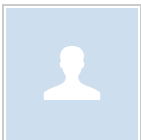
