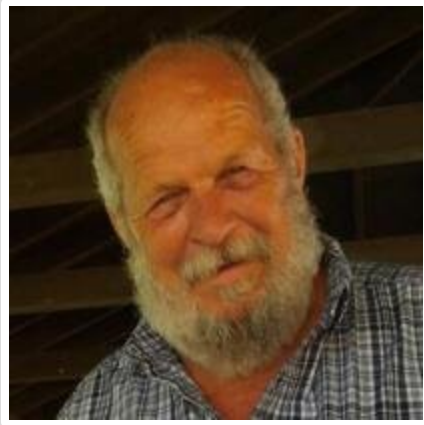




William "Bill" Wallace Frary
